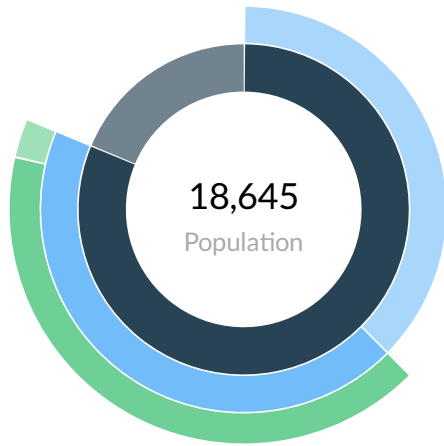
Median household income is **\$27.5K below** the national median household income of \$60.3K.

- As of 2020 the region's population **declined by 5.7%** since 2015, falling by 1,122. Population is expected to **decrease by 4.6%** between 2020 and 2025, losing 850.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **increased by 4.6%** in Marengo County, AL from 7,567 to **7,915**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 6.2% by 1.6%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 46.9% to 53.9% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.6% of Marengo County, AL residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.5% below the national average), and **8.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Services to Buildings and Dwellings, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

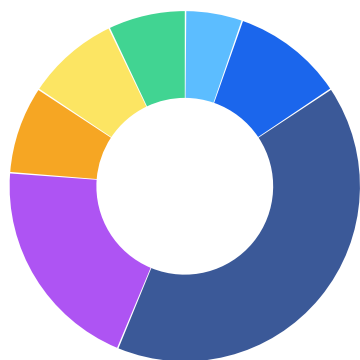

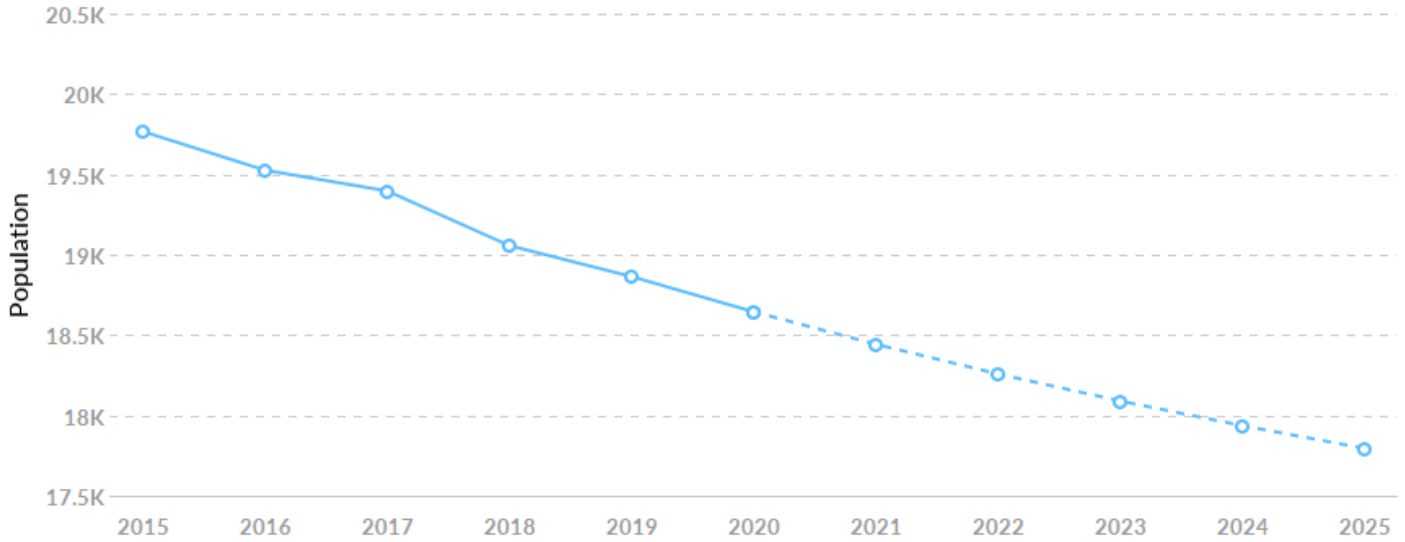

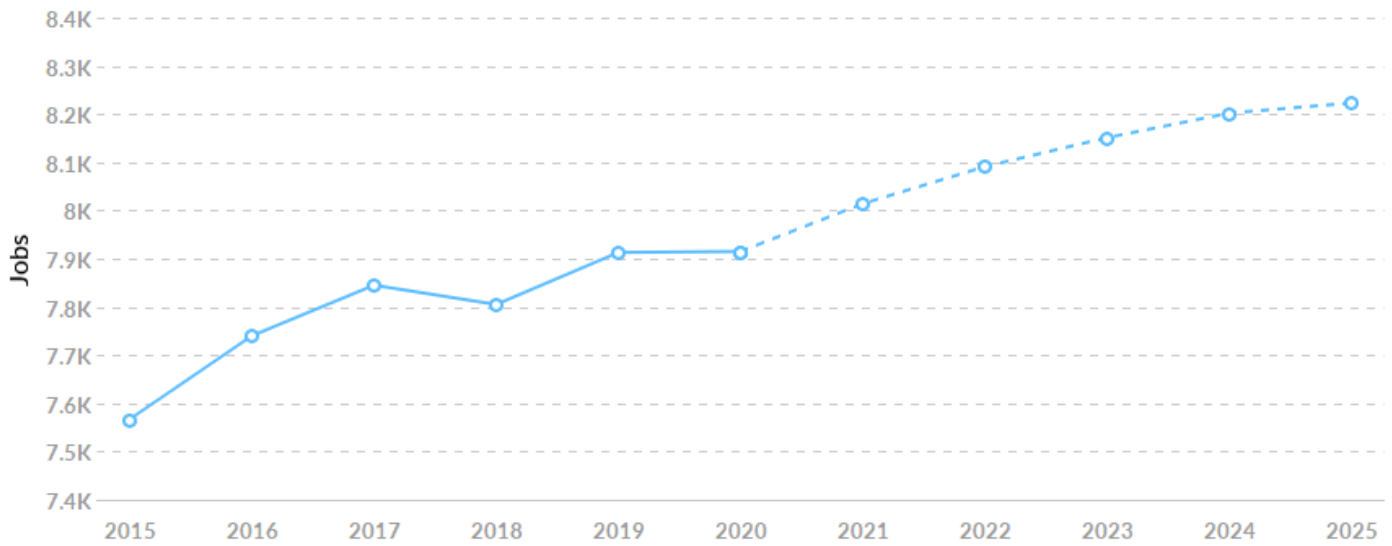

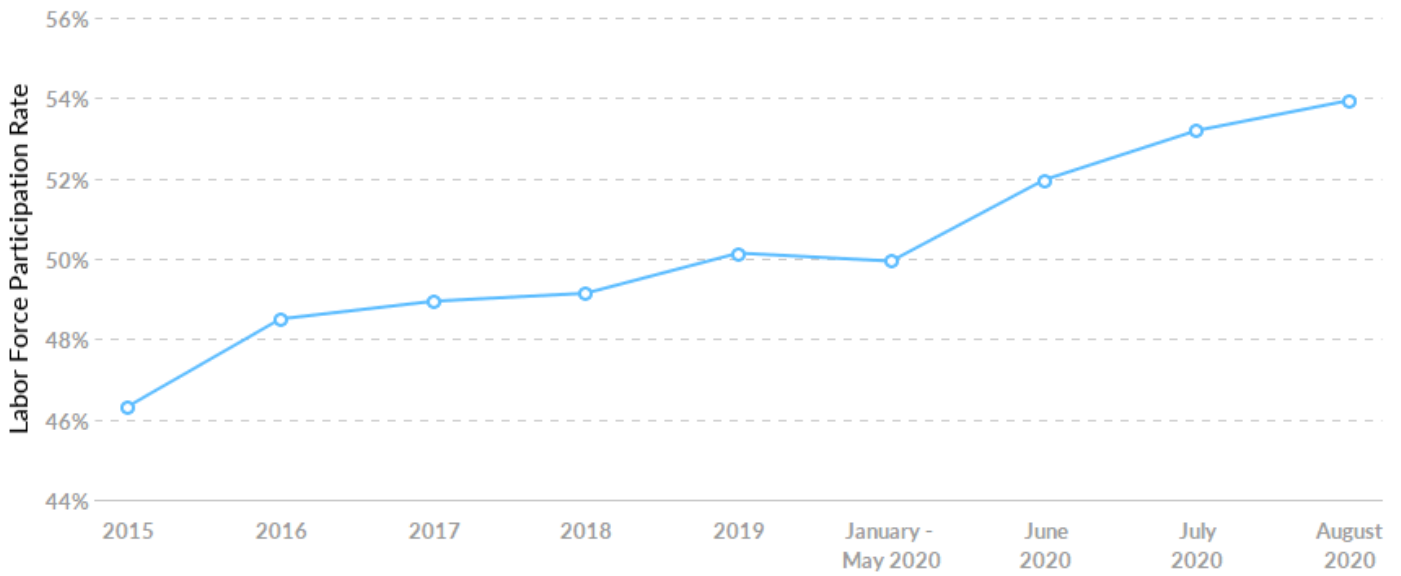
Job Trends

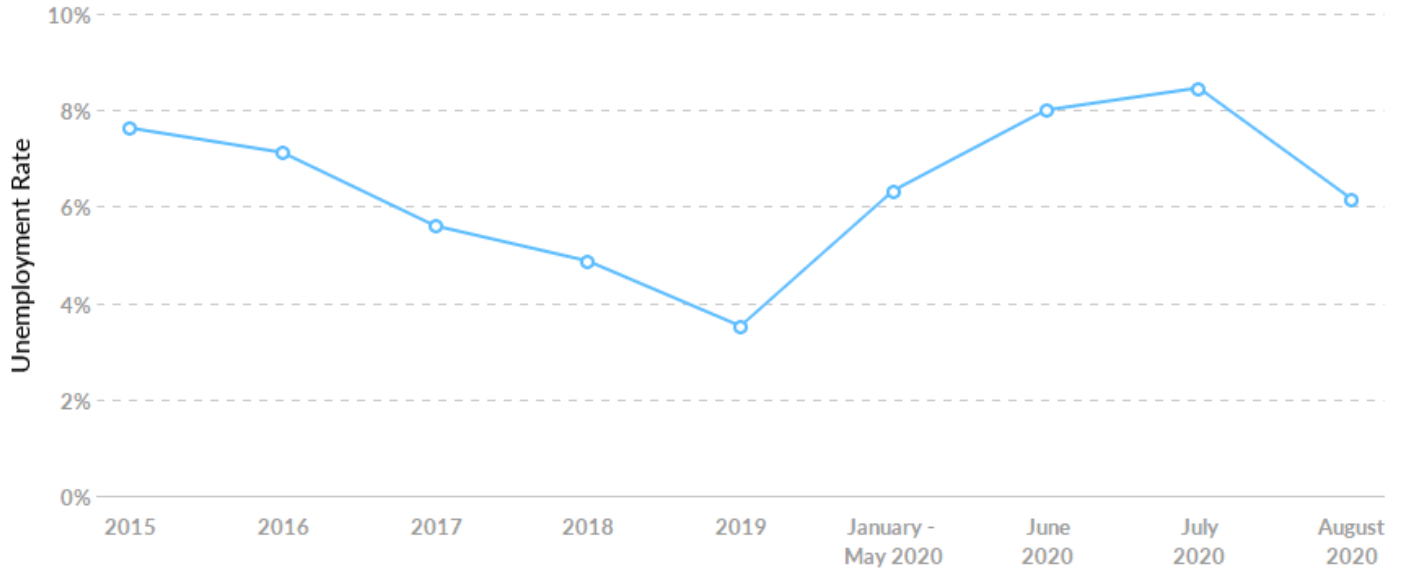

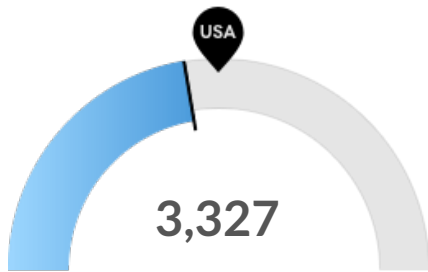
Unemployment Rate Trends

Marengo County, AL had an August 2020 unemployment rate of 6.16%, decreasing from 7.63% 5 years before.



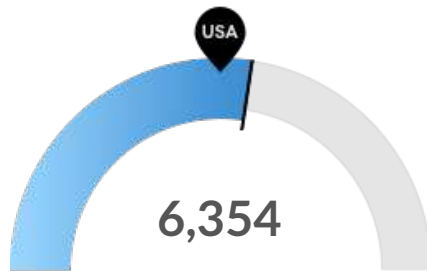

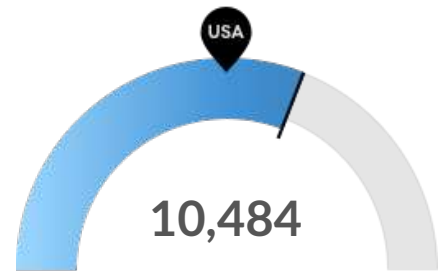
Millennials

Marengo County, AL has 3,327 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,889.



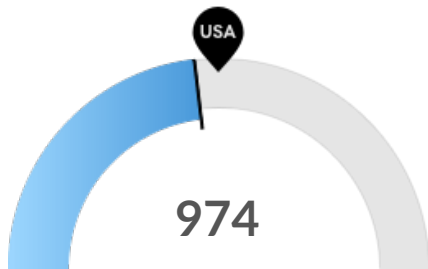
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Marengo County, AL. The national average for an area this size is 5,546 people 55 or older, while there are 6,354 here.



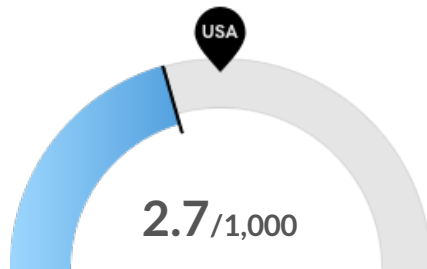
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Marengo County, AL. The national average for an area this size is 7,524 racially diverse people, while there are 10,484 here.



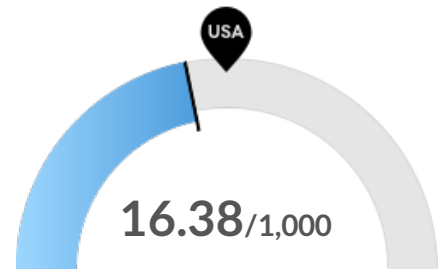
Veterans

Marengo County, AL has 2.7 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.

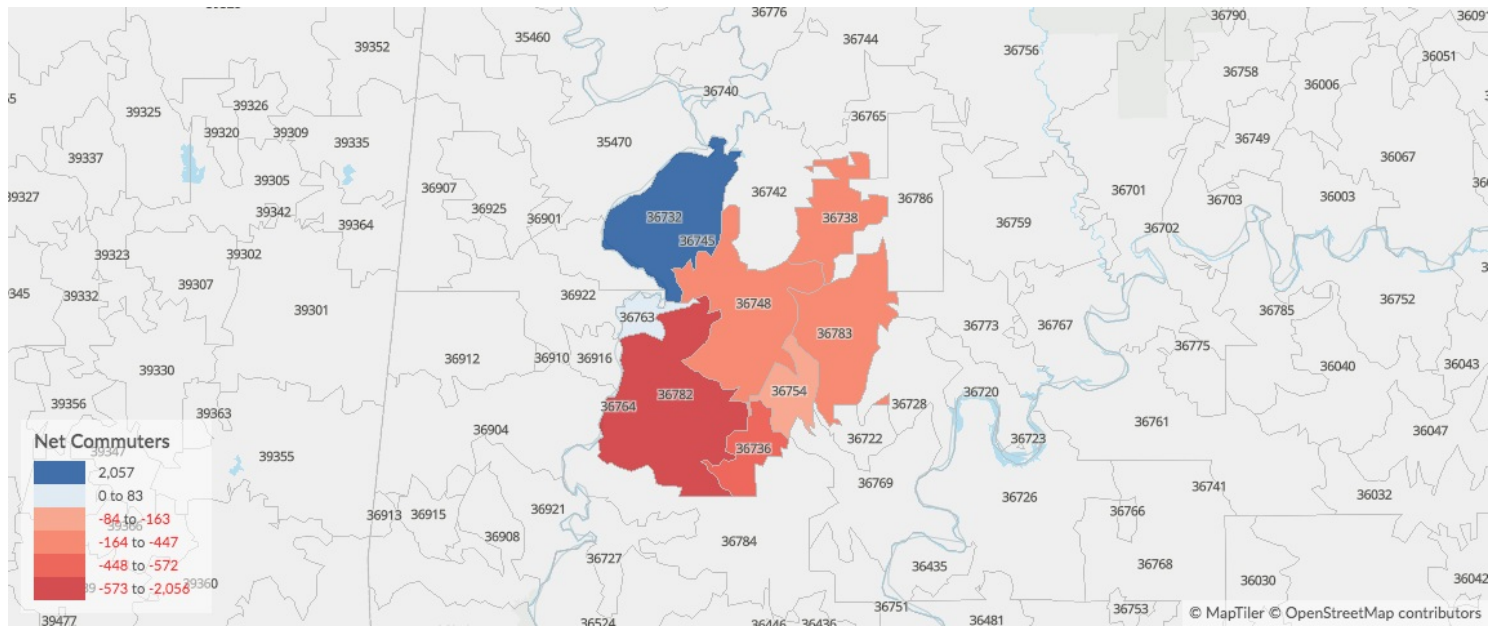


Property Crime

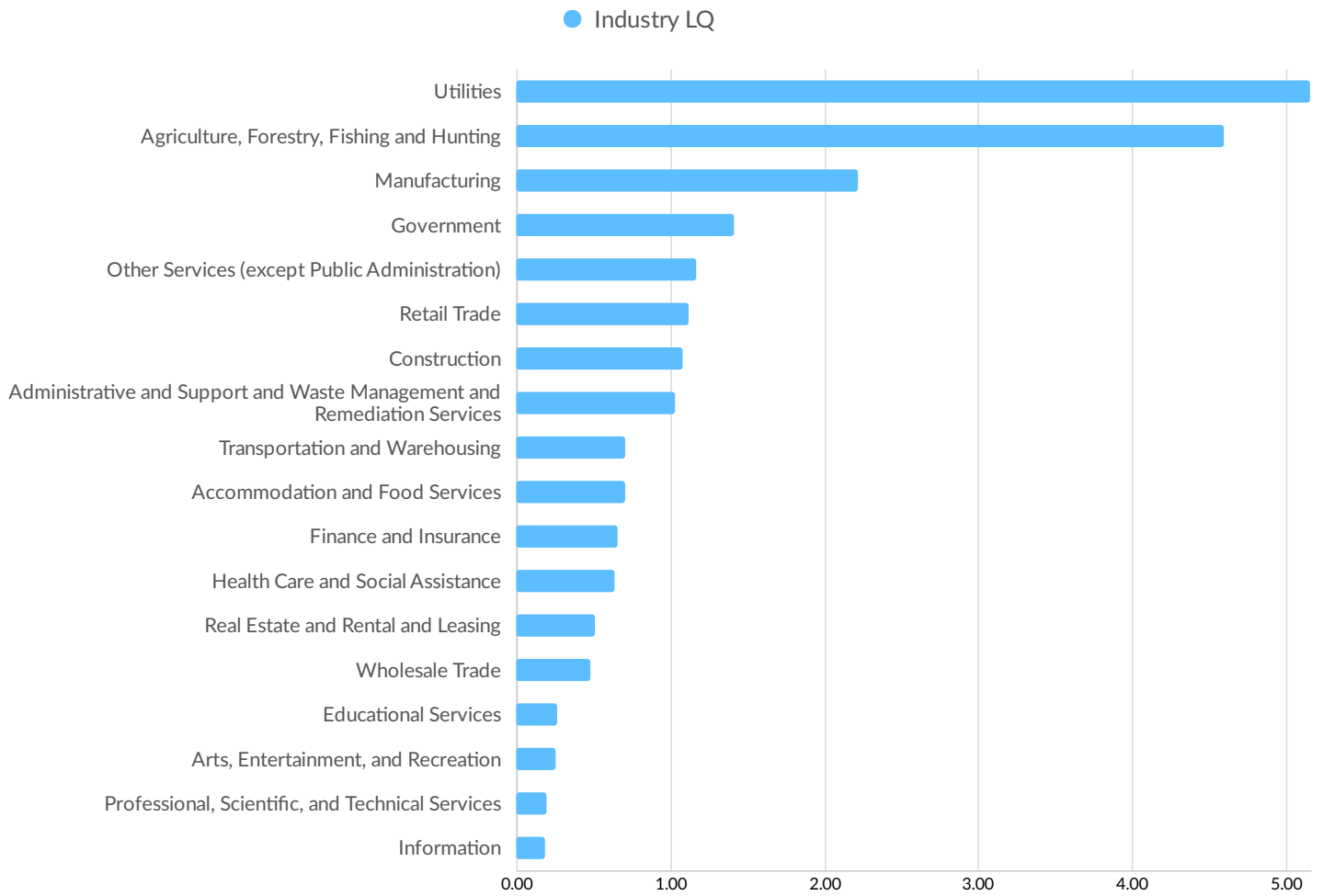

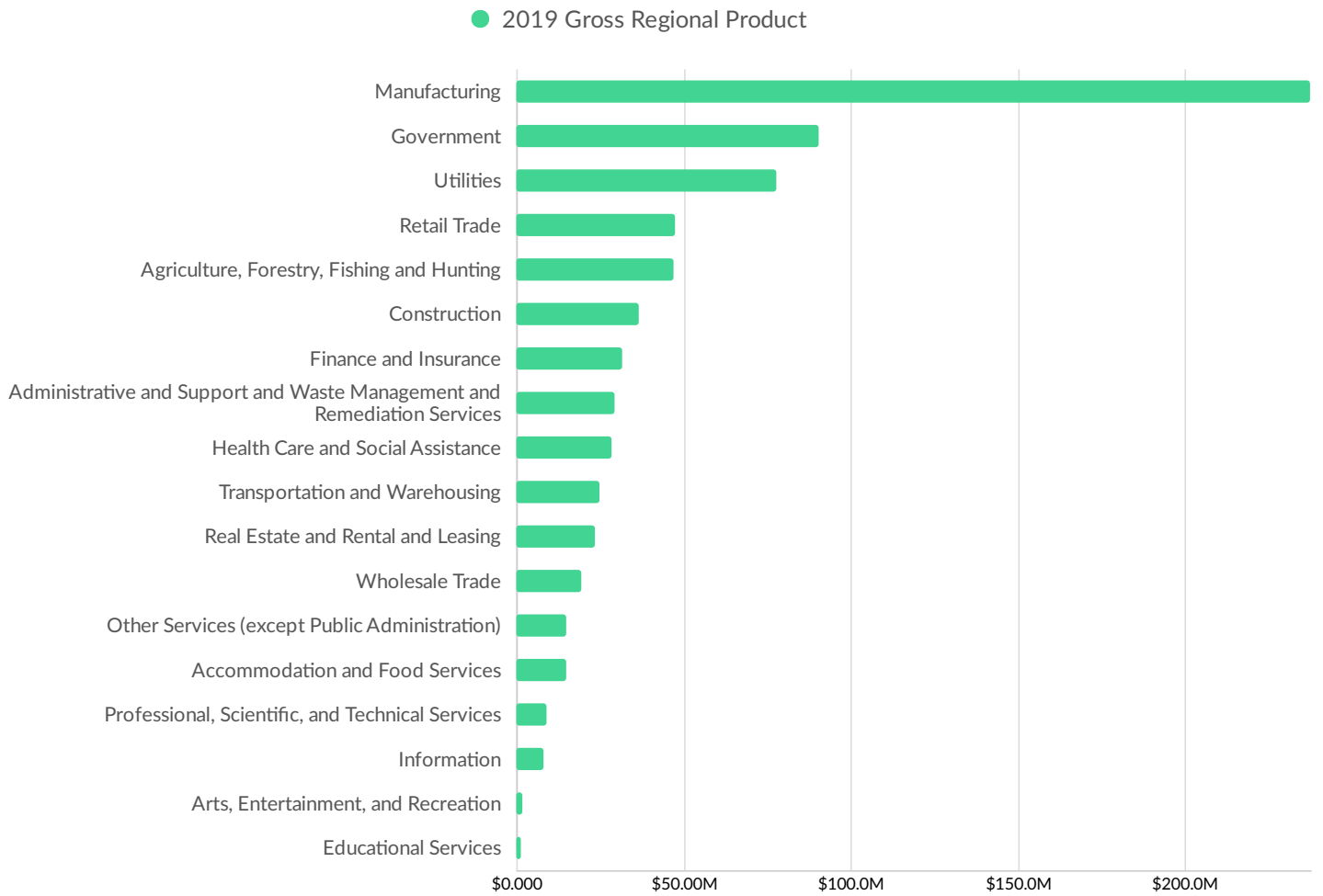
Top Growing Industries



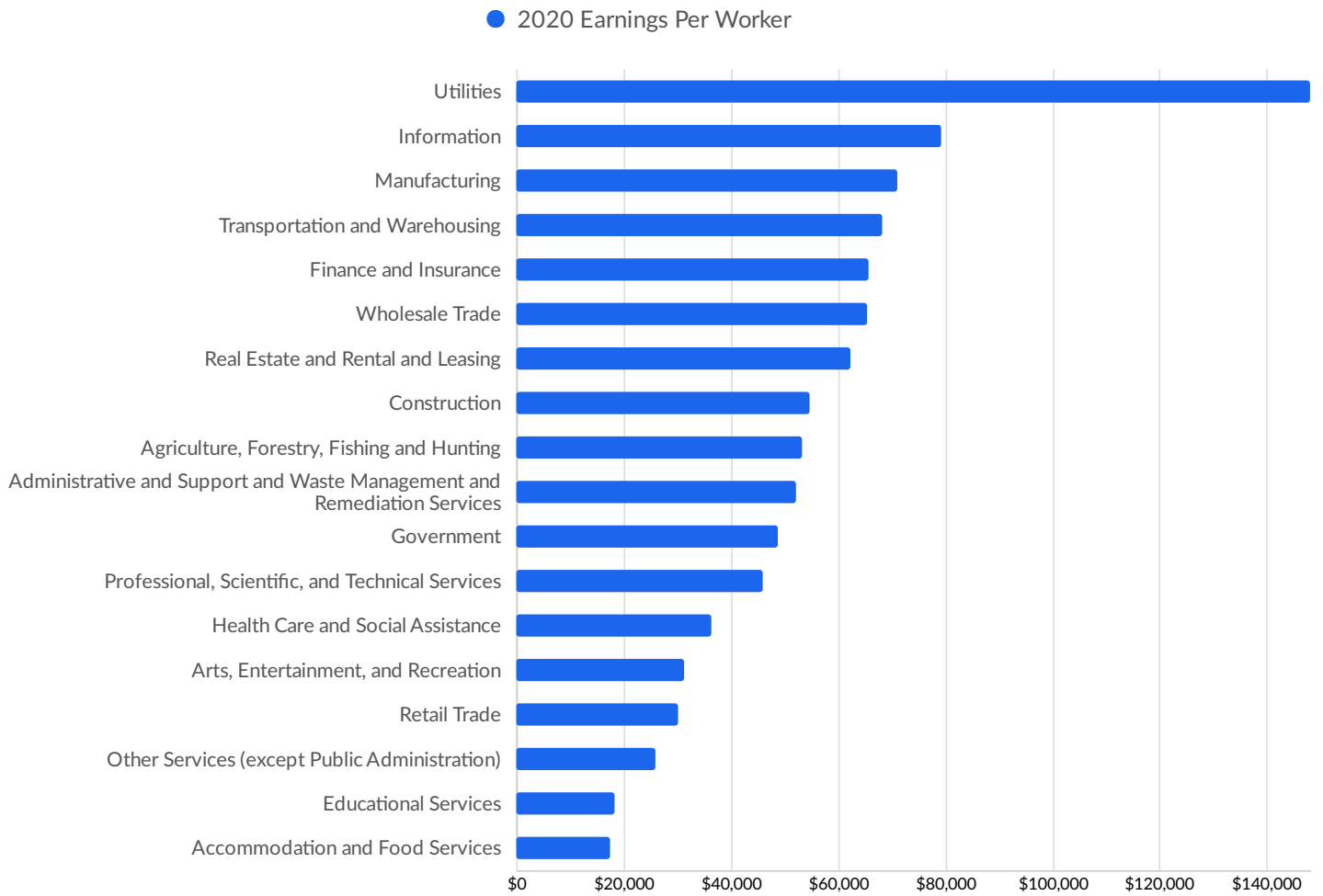

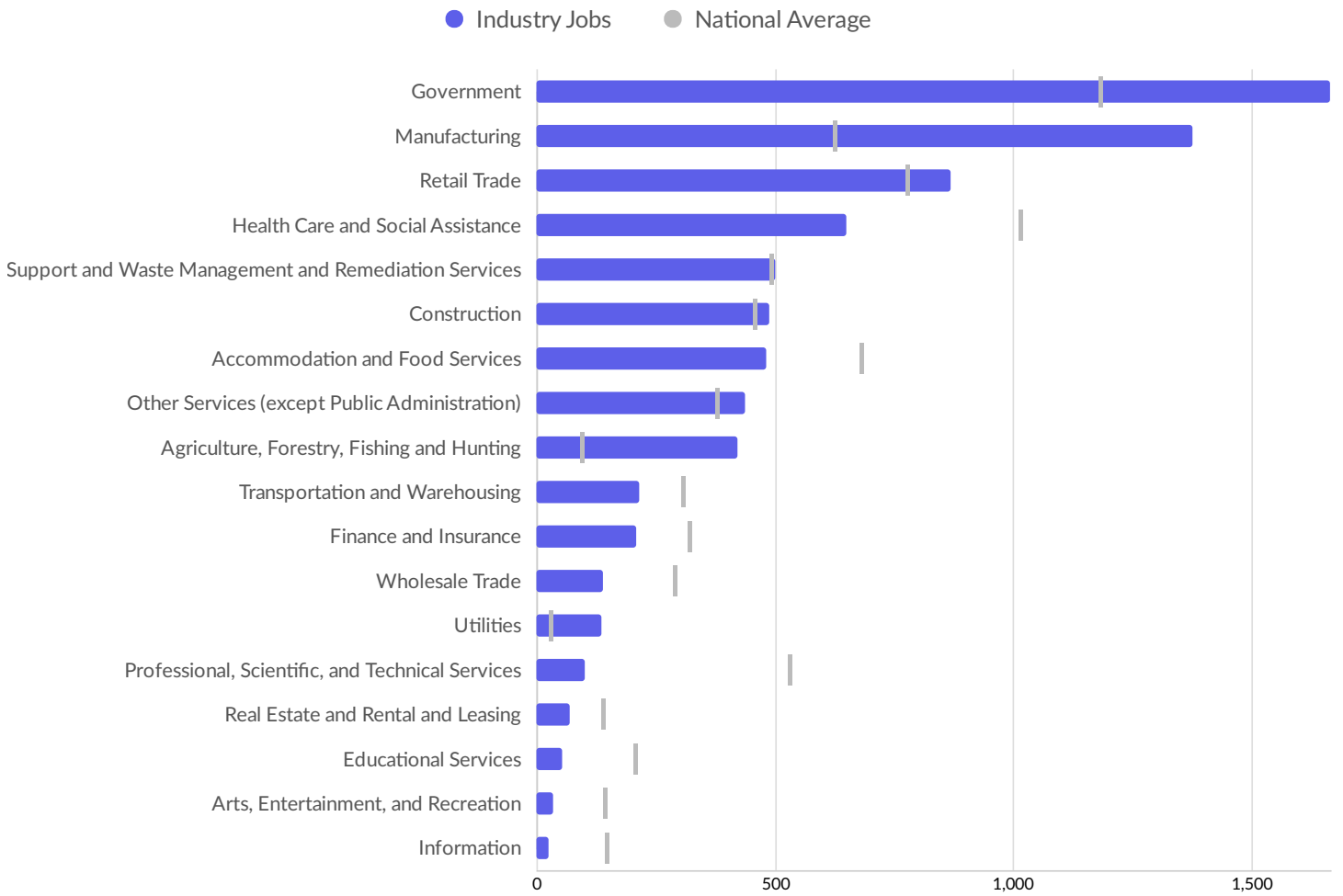

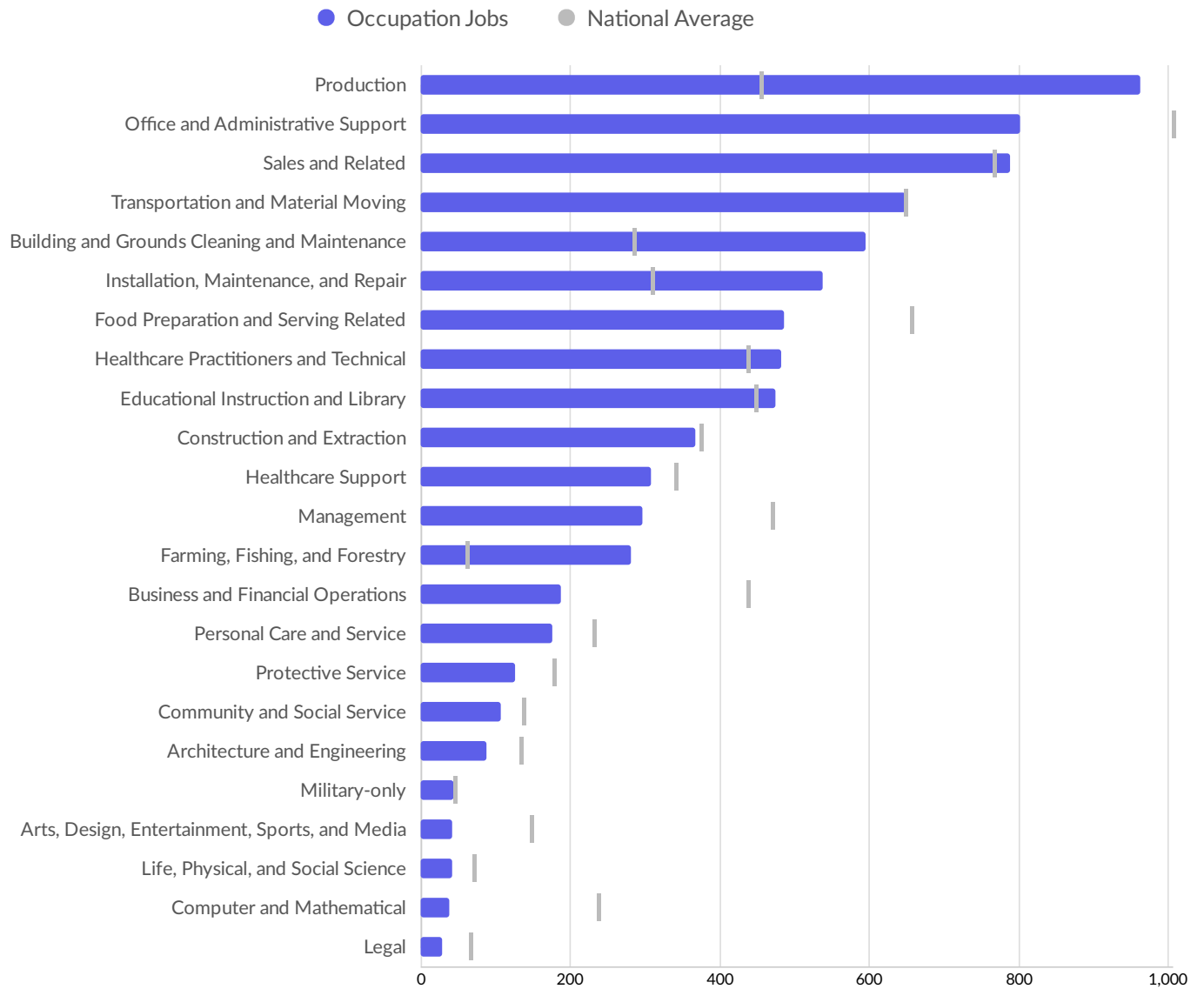

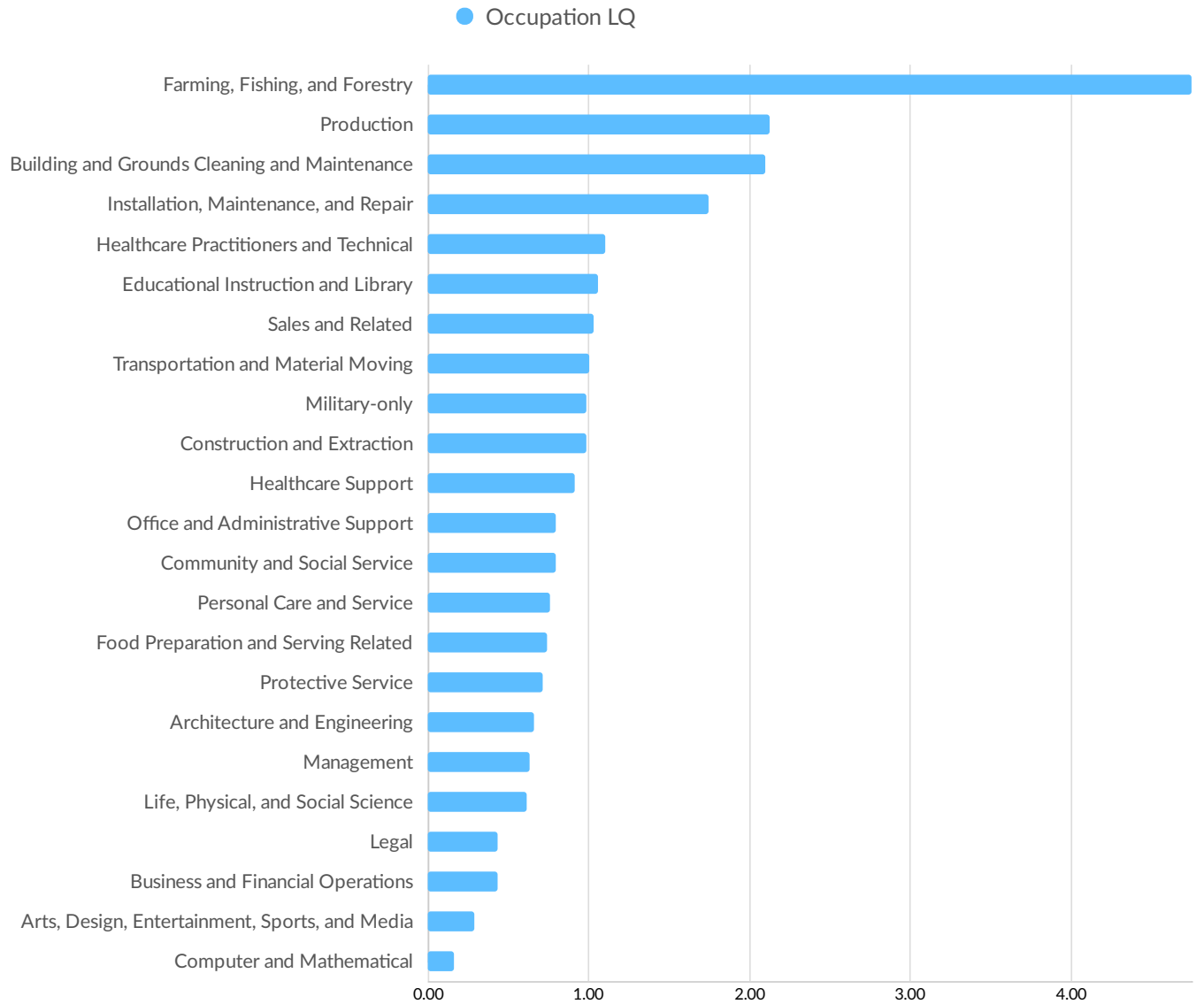

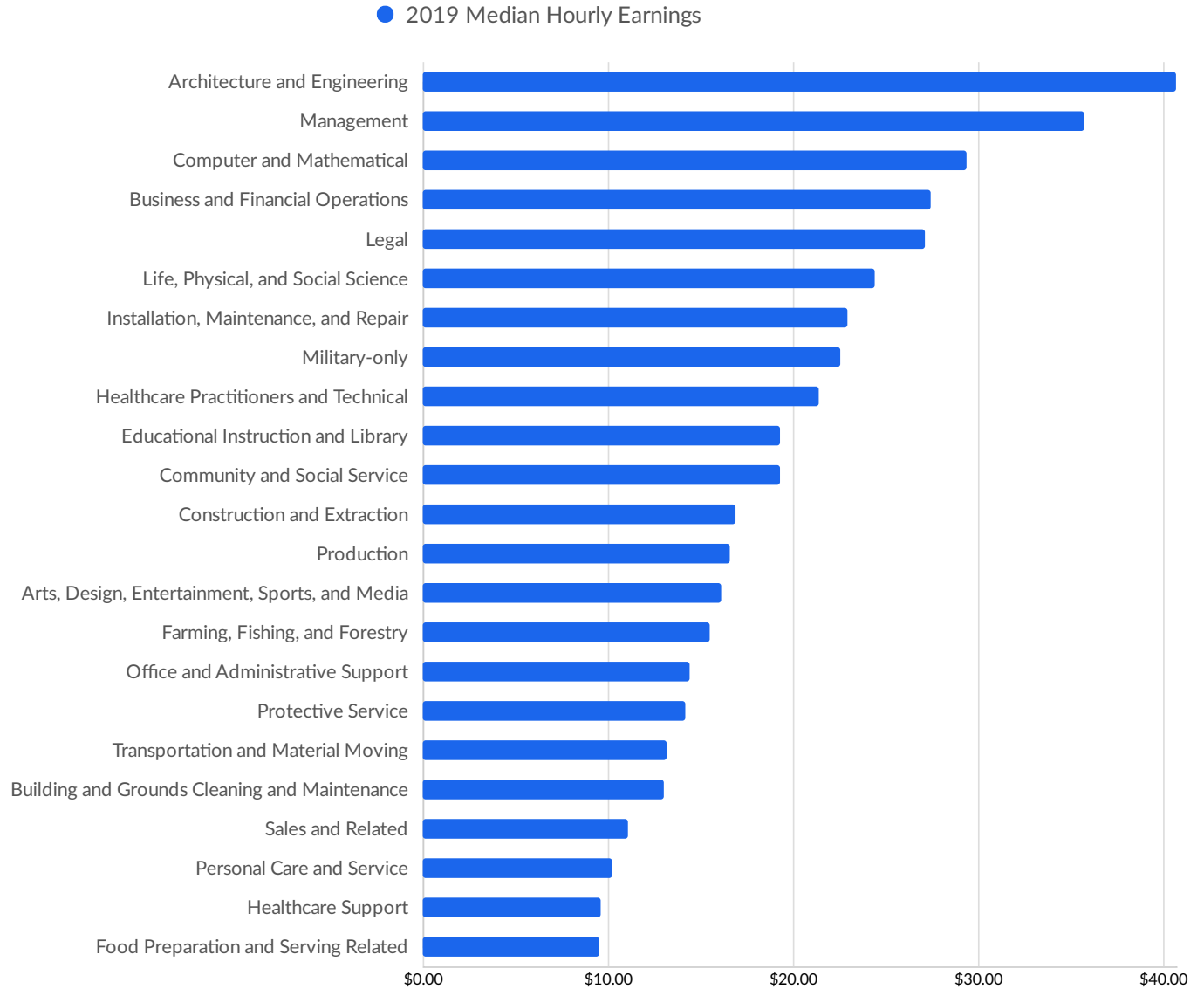

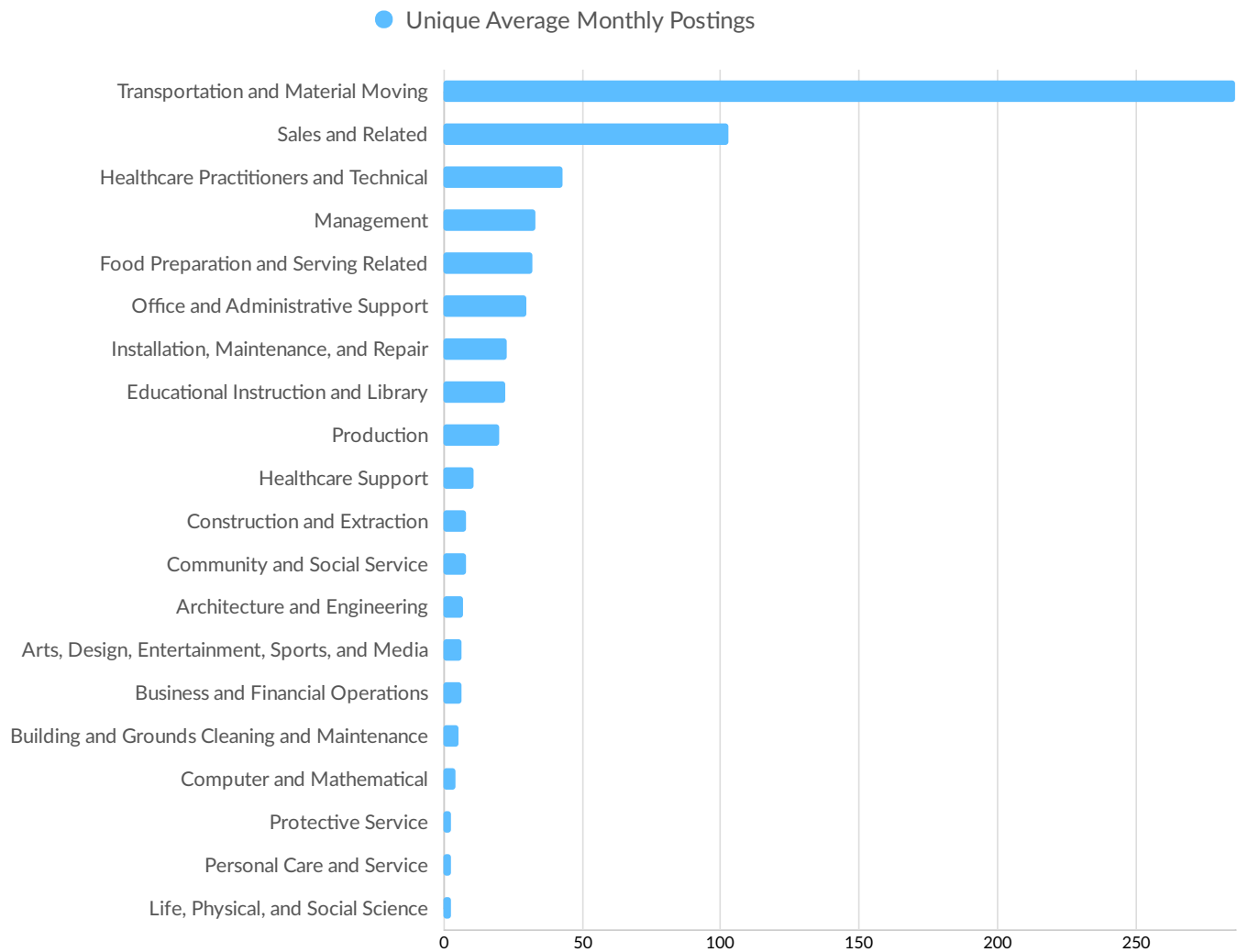

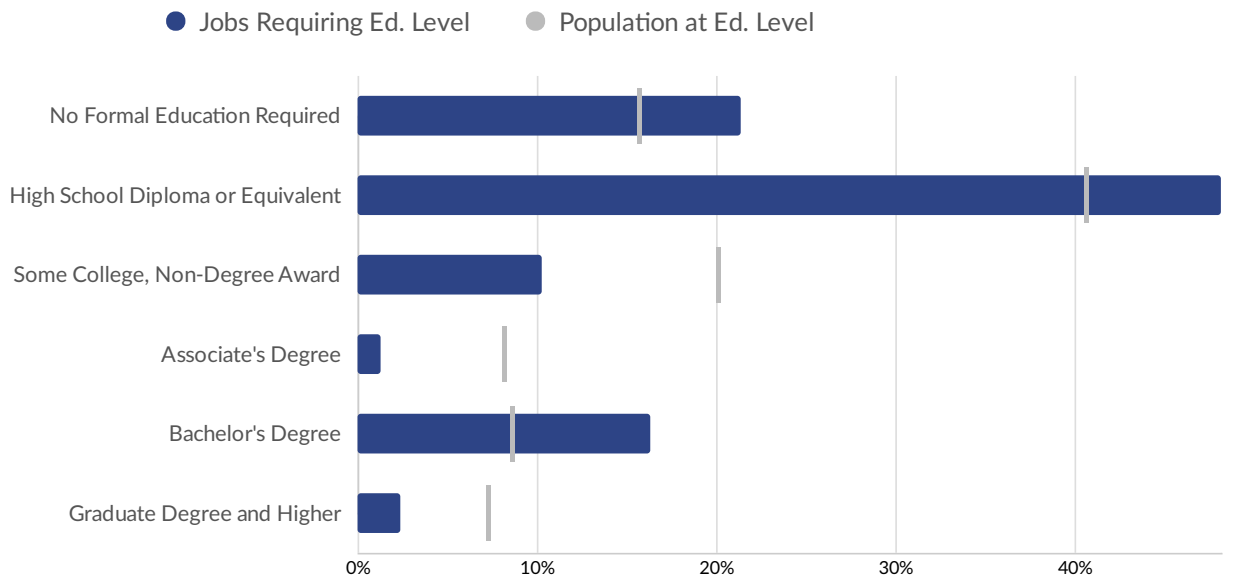

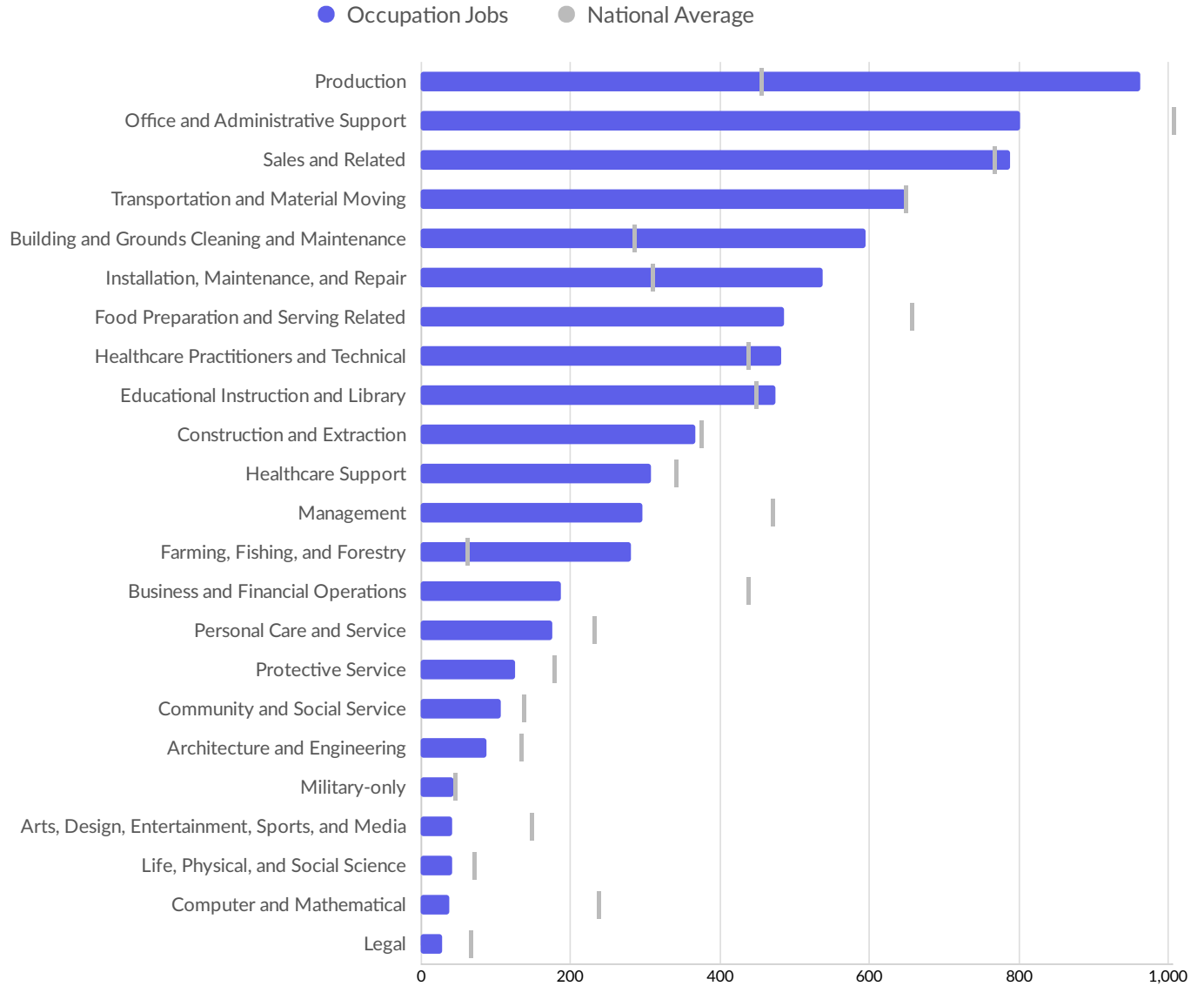
